

OCCA offers week end walk in Riddell State Park

The final nature walk organized by the Otsego County Conservation Association for 2009 will take place in The Robert V. Riddell State Park on Sunday, October 18 at 1:30 p.m. Park donors Patricia Riddell Kent and Steve Kent will guide a walk on the 800-acre portion of the park. Participants should meet at the Pine Lake Campus of Hartwick College, located in West Davenport. From there, they will carpool to the trailhead and proceed 4.5 miles through the park, to Mud Lake, and back to Pine Lake parking lot. If time permits, walkers will take a detour to a waterfall. Participants should bring sufficient water and a snack. The Pine Lake campus may be accessed from I-88 exit 16 or State Hwy. 7, taking County Hwy. 47 east to West Davenport and turning left on Charlotte Creek Road. The entrance to Pine Lake is just less than two miles on the right. Parking is on the left side, opposite the Robertson Center. To access the site from State Route 23, turn onto (Delaware) Co. Route 11, heading north and then right at Charlotte Creek Road and continue to the Pine Lake Campus, following the directions above. For information contact OCCA at director@occainfo.org or 547-4488.
